



On-the Job Training Program (OJT)

On-the-Job Training Program (OJT) is a federally funded program that helps employers hire and train workers for full-time, long term employment.

Through OJT programs, employers may be reimbursed up to 50 percent of the wages earned by eligible new trainees while they learn the job. This funding compensates you for training workers in skills they need to help your business thrive.

An OJT agreement must be developed before new employees are hired. Funding is available on a first-come, first-serve basis. Total reimbursement cannot exceed \$8,000, and the length of the training period cannot exceed six months.
